Frequently Asked Questions

What is the residency requirement at LaGrange College?

Full-time students are required to live on campus all four years unless:

- The student is 23 years of age or older on the first date of semester classes
- The student is married and living with their spouse
- The student is responsible for a dependent child
- The student is a veteran with at least two years of active military service
- The student resides exclusively with parent(s) or legal guardian(s) in their primary residence that is within a 30-mile commute of the college

When should I make my deposit?

The deadline is May 1 — make your deposit by then to receive a \$1,000 scholarship! Even better, if you make your deposit by April 1, LaGrange College will waive your orientation fee.
